Ramps | 1 | Ramps are not non-slip. | 4.5.1 | ADAAG requires ground and floor surfaces along accessible routes and in accessible rooms and spaces including floors, walks, ramps, stairs, curb ramps, shall be stable, firm, and slip-resistant. Add non-slip surface material. | M: Could add sign about slippery surface in mean time. | \$1,000 | Elkhart County General Fund | Slip resistant material installed. | | Sep-14 |
| 3. Parking | 2, 3 | No "Van Accessible" sign at van accessible parking space. No enforcement procedure for accessible parking. | 4.6.4 | ADAAG requires accessible parking spaces to be located in each parking lot. Accessible parking spaces are required to have upright signage that includes the symbol of a accessibility and van accessible signage where required. Add one "Van Accessible" sign. Enforce parking regulations. | L: Van spaces are provided, just no signage. May be snow in the way and not known w/out signs. | \$50 | Elkhart County General Fund | Van accessible sign installed | | Jul-14 |
| 4. Entrance | 4 | Edges are not securely installed to help minimize tripping hazards. | 4.5.3 | ADAAG requires if carpet or carpet tile is used on a ground floor or surface, than it shall be securely attached. Secure carpeting or mats at edges. | H: This can easily be fixed with little cost. | \$50 | Elkhart County General Fund | All removed | | Jul-15 |

Counters | 5 | At each type of cashier counter, there is a portion of the maincounter that is greater than 36 inches high. | 7.2 | ADAAG requires in areas used for transactions where counters have cash registers, at least one of each type shall have a portion of the counter which is at least 36 inches in length with a maximum height of 36 inches above the finish floor. Lower section of the counter. | M: Majority of customers use these counters. L: in some cases when cashiers can easily walk around. | \$3,000 | Elkhart County General Fund | Some counters removed | | Jul-18 |
| 6. Drinking Fountain | 6 | Drinking fountain does not have minimum clear floor space of at least 30 by 48 inches in front. | 4.15.5 | ADAAG requires fountains have a minimum clear floor space of 30 by 48 inches to allow a person in a wheelchair to approach the unit facing forward. Clear more room in order to meet minimum requirements. | L: Drinking fountains are not required. | \$150 | Elkhart County General Fund | Remove | 2023 | |
| 7. Drinking Fountain | 6 | No fountain with its spout no higher than 36 inches from ground, and another with a standard height. Controls are not mounted on front or on side near the edge, and are not operable with one closed fist. | 4.15.2 4.15.4 | ADAAG requires spouts shall be no higher than 36 inches, measured from the floor to spout outlet. Controls shall comply with 4.27.4 (Operable with closed fist). Unit controls shall be front mounted or side mounted near the front edge. Replace controls and lower fountain height. (or remove fountain) | L: Drinking fountains are not required. | \$150 | Elkhart County General Fund | Remove | 2023 | |
